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**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF COMMITTEE FOR APPOINTMENT ON
COMPASSIONATE GROUNDS HELD ON 07.04.2026
FOR CGST & CX, DELHI ZONE**

In terms of office order C.No. II-3(162)CCA/CA/Main File/2023/6854 to 6858 dated 20.03.2026, a departmental screening committee consisting of following officers was constituted by the Chief Commissioner of CGST, Delhi Zone for considering the cases of compassionate appointment:

- Ms. Anamika Singh, ADC (Chairman)
- Sh. Ravi Prakash, ADC (Member)
- Sh. Rajesh Kumar Meena, JC (In-Situ) (Member)

2. The meeting of the committee for compassionate appointments was held on 07.04.2026 to consider the applications for compassionate appointment in respect of the vacancy year 2025. In total, 55 cases (23 cases for the post of Tax Assistant and 32 cases for the post of Havaldar/MTS) were placed for consideration before the committee for available vacancy in the cadre of Tax Assistant and Havaldar/MTS for 01 Vacancy Tax Assistant and 01 vacancy for the post of Havaldar and Nil vacancy for the MTS for the vacancy year 2025 under compassionate appointment quota. During the meeting, the committee considered and discussed the applications/cases placed before it by the CCA Cell.

2.1 To give fair opportunity to all applicants, the financial verification alongwith other documents in respect of each applicant was called for from the respective Commissionerates by the concerned CCA Cell and **duly verified Proforma and Annexures by the Competent Authority** as forwarded by the commissionerates were checked and tabulated/compiled by the CCA Cell and further were placed before the Committee for consideration. The guiding principle for consideration of cases under Compassionate Appointment shall be in accordance with the DoPT's O.M. No. 14014/1/2022-Estt.(D) dated 02.08.2022.

3. **No. of vacancies:** As per the prevailing instructions for compassionate appointment, up to 5% of the Direct Recruitment vacancy can be filled up by compassionate appointment. Hence, the committee was informed about availability of vacancy year 2025 is as under:-

The above vacancy calculation has been done by the CCA Cell with the approval of the competent authority. The committee, accordingly, has taken the above vacancy position into consideration for the compassionate appointment exercise in respect to the vacancy year 2025.

4. The important instructions related to compassionate appointment policy as enumerated under DoPT's OM No. 14014/1/2022--Estt. (D) Dated 02.08.2022 are as follows:

- i. The object of the Scheme is to grant appointment on compassionate grounds to a dependent family member of a Government servant dying in harness or who is retired on medical grounds, thereby leaving his family in penury and without any means of livelihood, to relieve the family of the Government servant concerned from financial destitution and to help it get over the emergency.
- ii. Compassionate Appointment should be given to the dependent Members of the Government Servant who died in harness were appointed on regular basis and not one working on daily wage or casual or apprentice or ad hoc or contract or re-employment basis.
- iii. Dependent family members:
 - a) Spouse
 - b) Son (including adopted Son)
 - c) Daughter (including adopted daughters)
 - d) Brother or Sisters (In the case of unmarried Government Servant) who was wholly dependent on the Government servant at the time of his death in harness.
- iv. Married daughter can be considered subject to the condition that she was wholly dependent at the time of his/her death. She must support other dependent members of the family. Married son & married brothers can be considered dependent on a Government Servant as per DoPT's OM No. 14014/02/2012--Estt. (D) dated 16.01.2013.
- v. **Relaxation: As per para 6(B) (a) of the DoPT's OM No. 14014/1/2022--Estt. (D) dated 02.08.2022, age limit could be relaxed wherever found to be necessary. But the lower age limit should in no case be relaxed below 18 years. Age eligibility shall be determined with reference to the date of application but not the date of appointment. Authority competent to take a final decision for making compassionate appointment in a case shall be competent to grant relaxation of upper age limit also for making such appointment.**
- vi. Compassionate appointment can be made against 5% Group 'C' Direct Recruitment quota posts.
- vii. Appointment on Compassionate grounds should be made only on regular basis and that too only if regular vacancies meant for that purpose are available.
- viii. The Committee constituted for considering a request for appointment on compassionate grounds should limit its recommendation to appointment on compassionate grounds only in a really deserving case and only if vacancy meant for appointment on compassionate grounds will be available within a year in the

concerned administrative Ministry/Department/Office, that too within the ceiling of 5% of vacancies falling under DR quota in Group 'C' posts.

- ix. **Time limit for considering applications for Compassionate Appointment:** Prescribing time limit for considering applications for compassionate appointment has been reviewed vide DoPT's OM No. 14014/1/2022--Estt. (D) dated 02.08.2022. Subject to availability of a vacancy and instructions on the subject issued by DoPT and as amended from time to time, any application for compassionate appointment is to be considered without any time limit and decision taken on merit in each case.

5. The DoPT vide instructions F.No.14014/02/2012—Estt. (D) dated 16.01.2013 has issued consolidated instructions on compassionate appointment followed by FAQ's dated 30.05.2013 and 25.02.2015. As per the same and in the interest of transparency, CBIC has issued instructions vide F. No. A.12012/52/2018-Ad.III.B dated 15.05.2019 prescribing a mechanism/transparent roster point system to achieve the objective of the scheme of compassionate appointment and to ensure complete transparency. In line with the said CBIC instructions dated 15.05.2019, relative merit points are to be assigned to the applicants/candidates on various attributes on a 100-point scale as mentioned below:

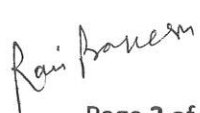

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additional points as grace points. She will be in line with the general principal that the widow needs to be given preference for compassionate appointment.

6. The committee in its meeting dated 07.04.2026 decided that for filling up the vacancies of compassionate appointment for the vacancy year 2025, applications received on or before 31st December 2024 will be considered. In total, **55 cases (23 cases for the post of Tax Assistant and 32 cases for the post of Havaladar/MTS)** were placed for consideration before the committee for available vacancy in the cadre of Tax Assistant and Havaladar /MTS for the vacancy year 2025 under compassionate appointment quota. The minimum educational qualification for the post of Tax Assistant is Graduation whereas for the post of Havaladar/MTS, it is 10th pass as per Recruitment Rules for the said posts.

7. The following 32 applications/cases for the compassionate appointment for the post of **Havaladar/MTS** were placed before the committee:-

Based on education qualifications and other prescribed eligibility criteria, the committee examined above 32 cases for the post of Havaladar/MTS as per their respective Recruitment Rules. The committee was apprised that financial verification in respect of some of the applicants eligible for the post of Havaladar/MTS was still pending as the necessary reports/documents are still awaited from the respective Commissionerate of the deceased employee. Therefore, the committee in the meeting dated 07.04.2026 gave directions to expedite the matter with their respective Commissionerates and to obtain the Financial verification report at the earliest. The Committee decided to examine these applications in the next screening committee meeting as and when the financial verifications are completed in respect of all applicants eligible for the post of Havaladar/MTS for the vacancy year 2025.

8.1 The Committee observed that Financial verification in respect of all 23 applications eligible for the post of Tax Assistant was complete and the committee decided to examine, discuss and consider all 23 applications for filling up the vacancy of 01 Tax Assistant for the VY 2025.

9. The CCA Cell maintains the records of each applicant in separate files. Such records/documents are received from the concerned commissionerate offices duly verified by

them in terms of their data/contents. Files of each applicant and the data compiled from the records including financial verification conducted were placed before the Committee for consideration. The CCA cell presented all the documents and duly verified verification reports in respect of the applicants received from their respective commissionerates including Part A, Part B and Part C, Annexure-I, Property declarations, 26AS/ITR or self-declared affidavit and other relevant documents. In addition to scrutiny of the documents/records of each applicants for the post of Tax assistant, following deviation/discretion has been applied by the committee in respect of below mentioned applicant:-

Case of Ms. Jasleen Walia, D/o Late Smt. Parminder Walia, Superintendent (Sl. No. 3 of the above table):

Fresh Financial verification of Ms. Jasleen Walia was sought by CCA Cell. In this regard, a Visit report at the declared address of Ms. Jasleen Walia, D/o Late Smt. Parminder Walia was submitted by the Assistant Commissioner (Estt.), CGST Panchkula Commissionerate wherein, it was submitted that the house was found locked and on enquiry from the neighbours for Ms. Jasleen Walia and her family member, it was informed that Ms. Jasleen Walia has moved to Canada after getting married. Therefore fresh financial verification of the candidate could not be completed and accordingly no points have been allotted in her case in the financial verification for the financial year 2025 and therefore her application was not considered by the committee.

10. Recommendations of the committee for the post of Tax Assistant are as under:-

- i. After careful examination of all available data/records of each applicants mentioned above, application of following 2 candidates (**in order of descending weightage points as per CBIC Board's instructions dated 15.05.2019**) were shortlisted by the committee against 01 vacancies for Compassionate grounds for the post of Tax Assistant for vacancy year 2025 keeping in view inter-alia their financial condition, eligibility for the post as per Recruitment Rules of Tax Assistant 2014, employability of the applicants, support from the family and liabilities on the dependents, taking into consideration DoPT's OM 14014/1/2022-Estt. (D) dated 02.08.2022 along with other instructions and points assigned as prescribed vide CBIC Board's instructions dated 15.05.2019 and 14.12.2020:-

Accordingly, the committee recommends the case of above mentioned 02 candidates (S. No. 1 to 2) for appointment on compassionate ground in the grade of Tax Assistant against the 01 available vacancy for compassionate appointment quota for the VY 2025. In respect of 02 selected candidates above, the appointment process may be taken up after the approval of the Competent Authority.

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ii. Further, applicant mentioned at **Sl. No. 2 above**) has also been shortlisted and recommended by the committee for consideration of appointment in case of one applicant in the final recommendation list do not get necessary age relaxation by the competent authority.

iii. Out of aforesaid shortlisted 2 applicants, one applicant namely Ms. Archana Rai (Sl. No.1) among the Top 2 applicants requires age relaxations as her age for the post exceed with prescribed 18-27 years in the Recruitment Rules of Tax Assistants. Such age relaxation are to be granted by the appointing authority as prescribed under para 6(b)(a) of the DoPT OM 14014/1/2022-Estt.(D) dated 02.08.2022. In view of the spirit of extending compassionate appointment and considering the dire financial condition of the family, the Committee recommends granting age relaxation to Ms. Archana Rai (Sl. No. 1) under Para 6(B) of DoPT O.M. No. 14014/1/2022-Estt.(D) dated 02.08.2022.

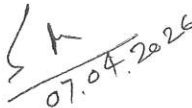
iv. However, in case Ms. Archana Rai does not get the necessary age relaxation by the Appointing Authority, it was also recommended by the committee to consider the next eligible candidate mentioned at Sl. No. 2 for appointment on compassionate grounds against the vacancy position for the VY 2025.

It may be mentioned that after approval of the Competent Authority, all other conditions, eligibility criteria, etc. are to be properly examined/verified by the CCA/Concerned Branch (TA Cadre) as per the conditions/eligibility criteria (including Computer/Skill Test) in Recruitment Rules and other instructions/rules etc., as prescribed.
